LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

CCC's Leadership Development Program (LDP) engages Jewish teens in grades 8–12 in meaningful and interactive community service. At our monthly sessions, we teach critical leadership skills and provide hands-on volunteer opportunities at CCC's community-outreach programs. With multiple locations around Atlanta, the 2025 cohort includes 315 teens.

Our LDP curriculum includes:

- Community-building & Jewish leadership
- Empathetic volunteering
- Fundraising skills
- Program planning & implementation

Book collections

CCC promotes literacy by distributing new or gently-used books to children at every program.

Smile Bag packs

Participants leave our programs with a Smile Bag—filled with essentials like personal care items, school supplies, a treat, and an educational toy—packed by volunteers from our community.

Toy drives

Each year, CCC distributes thousands of gifts at Amy's Holiday Party, giving children from 20+ social service agencies the chance to select multiple toys to take home.
