

Attendance requirements in order to re-register for LDP 2026:*

- * In 2025, attend a minimum of 5 out of 8 LDP sessions by November 7 (before the start of Session 9).
- * In 2025, volunteer at or register for a minimum of 3 programs by November 7 (before the start of Session 9). Registration for programs occurring after the date, including Amy's Holiday Party 2025, will count towards the minimum.
- * Please communicate with us about ongoing conflicts so that we can work with you. For session conflicts, email emily@cccprojects.org. For program conflicts, email aforbes@cccprojects.org and nate@cccprojects.org.

To be eligible to apply for the 2026 LDP Teen Executive Board, teens must:

- * Currently be in Tracks 2 or 3
- * Support CCC by raising money during the Annual Teen Fall Fundraiser by November 7 (before the start of Session 9).
- * In 2025, exceed the requirements for re-registration above by attending more than 5 sessions and more than 3 programs by November 7.
- *Participation check-ins/service hours updates will be emailed to you in both the spring and the fall. You may reach out to emily@cccprojects.org at any time for an update.
- *LDP runs January through December of each year. Program and session credits are calculated annually beginning in January (not by academic year).

*Credit for Session 8 (Annual Teen Fall Fundraiser) can be received in the following ways:

If you attend the in-person fundraiser and fundraise, you will receive a total of 2 service hours and 1 session credit.

If you attend the in-person fundraiser and do not fundraise, you will receive 1 service hour and 1 session credit.

If you attend the virtual support session and fundraise on your own, you will receive 1.5 service hours and 1 session credit.

Tracks 3 and 4 ONLY: If you fundraise on your own but do not attend either session, you will receive 1 service hour and 1 session credit.

If you do not participate in Session 8, you will not receive a session credit or service hours.
